




1. What is Bookopoly?


Bookopoly is a fun new reading challenge from the LRC. Inspired by the traditional board game, Bookopoly is free and easy to play, and open to students with all levels of reading ability. The competition is open from **Monday 10th February – Thursday 3rd April**.

2. How to play Bookopoly

Playing Bookopoly couldn't be easier, all you need is your student ID card and a passion for reading books.

- Simply collect your gameboard from the LRC helpdesk and select what you would like to read from our wide range of books in your chosen category.
- You must read two books from at least one category, plus one book from one of the four special choice categories, to be eligible for entry into our prize draw.
- For example, you could read two books from the Science Fiction category, plus one Biography, or two books from the Fantasy category plus one Travel book, as shown below.

- Each time you read a book, return it to a member of staff in the LRC, and your gameboard will be stamped to record your progress. Submit your completed (and stamped) gameboard by the closing date to be entered into the prize draw.

3. Book Categories

There are 8 main book categories and 4 special choice categories. All categories cover both fiction and non-fiction books, as well as books for all reading levels and abilities, including Quick Reads, Penguin Readers, Scholastic Readers and any of our other entry level titles.

The 8 main categories are:








- Horror
- Fantasy
- Historical & Classics
- Romance & Comedy
- Science Fiction (Sci-Fi)
- Thriller
- Film or TV
- General (non-fiction)

The 4 special choice categories are:

- Travel
- Biography
- Quick Reads
- Graphic Novels

4. The Gameboard

The 'gameboard' (pictured below) is based on the traditional Monopoly boardgame and is primarily used to track your progress through the game.

Each time you read a book and return it to the LRC, a member of staff will stamp the corresponding category on your board, so please make sure you look after it, don't lose it, and keep it in good condition!

On the reverse of the board, you will find our Terms and Conditions, as well as a space to write your name and student number. The gameboard is also your entry form, please make sure to submit your completed form, including your name and student number, before the closing date of the competition, **Thursday 3rd April**. Completed forms will not be accepted after this date.

5. Suggested Titles

Please speak to a member of staff in the LRC if you would like some advice and guidance about the range of books available in each of our selected categories. We will be more than happy to make a recommendation, or provide some inspiration to help you find your next favourite read!

6. The Prizes

All students who submit a completed gameboard by the closing date will be entered into a prize draw, with the winner drawn at random by a member of LRC staff.

The prize will consist of a voucher redeemable with Amazon.co.uk. There are three different prizes, with each prize drawn separately:

- Complete **one** category + one special choice category (**3 books in total**) to be entered into the draw for **3rd prize**.
- Complete **two** categories + one special choice category (**5 books in total**) to be entered into the draw for **2nd prize**.
- Complete **three** categories + one special choice category (**7 books in total**) to be entered into the draw for **1st prize**.

7. Terms and Conditions

1. Only one entry per student permitted.
2. Only members of OSC colleges can enter the competition.
3. Books can only be borrowed on presentation of a current ID badge.
4. Only books borrowed from the LRC are eligible for the competition.
5. Only books read between Monday 10th February 2025 and April 3rd 2025 can be included in the competition.
6. The LRCs use of particular brands as prizes does not imply any affiliation with or endorsement of such brands.
7. The winner will be drawn at random.
8. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be offered.
9. We reserve the right to substitute prizes with another prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to do so.
10. The decision of the LRC regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding.
11. The winner will be notified after 3rd April 2025 via their student email.
12. The LRC will attempt to contact the winner by email up to two times. If the winner does not respond to the emails notifying them of their win within 14 days of the second email, they will lose their right to the prize, and the LRC reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.
13. The LRC reserves the right to cancel the prize draw or amend these terms and conditions at any time, without prior notice.
